Towneley students will be accessing lessons as part of a core topic that will promote more independent life skills as part of their preparation for adulthood.

As part of our lessons, your son/daughter will be taking part in weekly visits to ASDA. The visits will be every Monday morning, and students will have the opportunity to engage in real life money and shopping situations.

Students will be supported to run a shopping service for the college, and will have the opportunity to choose and purchase items for themselves, both in the supermarket and the café. Please could you send spending money as required.

We will also be starting basic food preparation and meal making on a Friday morning. Students will be supported to choose and prepare recipes of their choice to bring home, and will link to our core topic. A contribution of £2 per week towards this is recommended in order to allow students to purchase their own ingredients. Please could you send in a container to allow students to bring their food home.

The college café snack bar is open at break times, where students can purchase toast, crumpets, juice, and other items as available. The snack menu for this half term is:
