COVID-19 Positive cases (during the holidays)

Free School Meals

Please note that once again there will be Edenred vouchers emailed for those families on free school meals. For those families that we know have limited internet access we will arrange this separately.

Drop off and Collection times

The transport drop-off and collection window will reduce from 15 minutes to 10 minutes. This does not affect those students that travel on LCC transport, but if you bring your child in, then please note the new times. This still allows for flexibility and avoids clashing with PVC students who are still using all the fire exits and so cross over our drop off and collection points. The drop off and collection times from Monday 4th January 2021 will be:

drop off 8:50 – 9:00

collection 3:00 – 3:10

Upon arrival please remain in your car until you are called in. **If you arrive later than this, then please go to reception to drop off/ collect your child.**
